We Are in a Spiritual Battle

For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. (Ephesians 6:12).

It is important to remember that we are in a spiritual battle. Satan and His forces are out to take from us what the Lord has graciously given to us. In the rest of this passage Paul tells us to put on the armor of God and STAND. Our job is not to "fix things" it is to hold the ground that we have already been given.

Satan will work hard to distort truth, (the first piece of God's armor). He will try to rob our joy and diminish our witness. He cannot take us from the Lord, but He can keep us from taking others with us. Our strength is in Him . . . not in us! It is not up to us to "fix" the world or others. Our job is to preach the Word of God . . . to point to Him! To stand on the truth of the gospel.

Since we are fighting a spiritual battle, we must remain close to our spiritual strength. Paul tells us to clothe ourselves in the righteousness of Christ, the precious truth of our salvation because of Jesus, the peace of God which we hopefully extend to others, the shield of faith . . . trusting God to give us the tools we need and to make right what is wrong (He will do a much better job than we can do). We are to take on the sword of the Spirit which is the Word of God, and we should do all of it in the spirit of prayer.

The smart soldier remains with his fellow soldiers. We are a much easier target when we are alone than when we are together. Let's not shoot our fellow soldiers but instead rely on each other for wisdom, encouragement, and support.



Cream together: 1 cup sugar 2 TBSP, butter



Add and mix 2 eggs

Sift together and add: 1-1/2 cups flour 1 tsp. Baking powder ½ tsp. Salt


Stir in: 1/2 cup milk lemon zest


