

#### **CREAMY POTATO STICKS**

Sue Fridman (Sue Simmons Family)

½ tsp. salt
1-½ cup milk
1 can cream of celery soup, undiluted
½ lb. American cheese, cubes
5 to 6 large baking potatoes, peeled
1 cup chopped onion
Paprika


In a saucepan, combine flour and salt. Gradually whisk in milk until smooth. Bring toa boil, cook and stir for 2 minutes. Remove from heat, whisk in soup and cheese until smooth. Set aside. Cut potatoes into 4"x½'x½" sticks. Place in greased 9x13" pan or baking dish. Sprinkle with onion. Top with cheese sauce. Bake uncovered at 350° for 55 to 60 minutes or until potatoes are tender. Sprinkle with paprika. Yield: 6 servings.


