WINTER STEW DELIGHT

Combine:

- 1 small head cabbage, chopped
- 4 medium potatoes, diced
- 4 medium onions, diced
- 1 28-oz. can diced tomatoes
- 1 pound carrots, peeled and sliced
- 2 pounds Italian sausage, fried and drained
- 4 cups beef broth
- 1 cup tomato juice (or V8 juice)
- 1 15-oz. can black beans (or kidney or pinto beans) salt to taste


Cover and back at 350° for 1 ½ to 2 hours until tender, stirring occasionally. If necessary add more broth or juice. Freezes well. Fills a large roaster pan as written, but recipe can be easily halved.
