Most of the shoeboxes for our church have been taken and are being filled.


The deadline for dropping off completed shoeboxes at a drop off location in Olean or Allegany is November 17–24, and we would like to have our church's boxes ready by October 31.

The best news is that we raised more money than in any previous year, bringing in \$6,771.50. (Our church gave \$565).

Approximately \$1,690 will benefit our local food pantry while more than \$5,000 will support the work of Church World Service.

### **FARM HOUSE COOKIES**

Sandy LaFever

1 cup shortening

2 cups sugar

Add:

Cream:

2 eggs

1 cup sour cream 1 tsp. vanilla

Mix and add:

4 ½ cups flour ½ tsp salt

½ tsp baking soda

4 tsp baking powder



Chill if very soft. Roll on floured board, fairly thick (1/2") Cut with round cutter. Bake on ungreased cookie sheet at 375° for 10-12 minutes. Sprinkle with granulated sugar, or press a little jam or jelly in center.

The badly worn **shingles have been replaced on our church steeple** and an eavestrough was installed.
